Thank you for your willingness to participate as an Intern in the upcoming Graduate Internship program. If accepted, you will receive 13 weeks (100 hours) of training, April 10 to July 10, to broaden and enhance your confidence and competence as a Nutrition Consultant. Your Internship - cost \$295 (\$995 value)

Weeks 1 and 2: On Saturdays (10:00 am - 5:00 pm), Interns will become familiar with the forms and articles in the **Consultant Internship Manual**, learn consultation principles, scope of practice, and case reporting guidelines, while deepening their understanding of the Intake session components, Personal Health Plan, Handouts, Meal Plans, and follow-up sessions. Working in teams of 2, Interns will complete consultation exercises, exchanging lead and secondary roles.

Weeks 3 through 12: Intern teams will carry out consultations for about 4 hours per week. After a client receives an initial supervised on-site session, 3 sessions by phone will follow. Interns will also devote about 3 hours per week to writing client reports, health plans, and educational materials. The Supervisor will carefully review all documents. Additionally, Interns will participate in a weekly 1-hour case review teleconference with a key College staff member.

Week 13: Two 3-hour on-site sessions will offer final case summaries and program review

Your Eligibility

The Applicant must be a Bauman College certified Nutrition Consultant and provide:

- ♦ Proof of Professional Liability Insurance policy or pending application
- ♦ Proof of NANP Membership
- ♦ A 300-word essay explaining the prospective Intern's life aspirations, professional focus, and areas of expertise (the essay guidelines will appear on the application)
- ♦ Participation in an interview with the program Supervisor, resulting in a positive evaluation

Your Responsibility

Upon acceptance, the Applicant will be obligated to:

- ♦ Complete payment of the \$295 fee
- ♦ Complete and return by US mail the Internship Contract
- ♦ Be available for in-person Intake consultations on all weekends in late April and early May
- ♦ Attend training, as well as July 10th final review classes, complete assigned client work and consultations during the 10-week Consultation period, and participate in all teleconferences
